Biblically, a fool is one who is senseless, one who disgraces, one who lacks honor, one who falls, one who makes vile.

### The end result of foolishness

#### Affliction

Psalms 107:17 Fools, because of their transgression, And because of their iniquities, were afflicted.

Ecclesiastes 4:5 The <u>fool</u> folds his hands and consumes his own flesh.

Ecclesiastes 10:12 The words of a wise man's mouth *are* gracious, But the lips of a <u>fool</u> shall swallow him up.

Proverbs 29:9 If a wise man contends with a foolish man, Whether *the <u>fool</u>* rages or laughs, *there is* no peace.

### Loss of inheritance and wealth

Psalms 49:10 For he sees wise men die; Likewise the <u>fool</u> and the senseless person perish, And leave their wealth to others

Proverbs 11:29 He who troubles his own house will inherit the wind, And the <u>fool</u> *will be* servant to the wise of heart.

Proverbs 21:17 He who loves pleasure *will be* a poor man; He who loves <u>wine</u> and oil will not be rich.

#### Shame

Proverbs 3:35 The wise shall inherit glory, But shame shall be the legacy of <u>fools</u>.

### **Failure**

Proverbs 10:8 The wise in heart will receive commands, But a prating <u>fool</u> will fall.

#### Madness

Ecclesiastes 10:13 The words of his mouth begin with <u>foolishness</u>, And the end of his talk *is* raving madness.

### Violence

Proverbs 26:6 He who sends a message by the hand of a <u>fool</u> cuts off *his own* feet *and* drinks violence.

### Sorrow

Proverbs 17:21 He who begets a scoffer *does so* to his sorrow, And the father of a <u>fool</u> has no joy.

### Perish

Psalms 49:10 For he sees wise men die; Likewise the <u>fool</u> and the senseless person perish, And leave their wealth to others.

Proverbs 1:32 For the turning away of the simple will slay them, And the complacency of <u>fools</u> will destroy them;

Proverbs 10:21 The lips of the righteous feed many, But <u>fools</u> die for lack of wisdom.

Proverbs 13:20 He who walks with wise *men* will be wise, But the companion of <u>fools</u> will be destroyed.

Proverbs 26:10 The great *God* who formed everything gives the <u>fool</u> *his* hire and the transgressor *his* wages.

Romans 3:23 The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ our Lord

### What fools think, say, and do

#### Attitude and heart condition

Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge, *But* <u>fools</u> despise wisdom and instruction.

- Proverbs 1:22 How long, you simple ones, will you love simplicity? For scorners delight in their scorning, And <u>fools</u> hate knowledge.
- Proverbs 12:15 The way of a <u>fool</u> is right in his own eyes, But he who heeds counsel is wise.
- Proverbs 13:19 A desire accomplished is sweet to the soul, But *it is* an abomination to <u>fools</u> to depart from evil.
- Proverbs 14:8 The wisdom of the prudent is to understand his way, But the folly of fools is deceit.
- Proverbs 16:22 Understanding *is* a wellspring of life to him who has it. But the correction of <u>fools</u> *is* folly.
- Proverbs 17:10 Rebuke is more effective for a wise *man* than a hundred blows on a fool.
- Proverbs 17:24 Wisdom *is* in the sight of him who has understanding, But the eyes of a <u>fool</u> *are* on the ends of the earth.
- Proverbs 19:3 The <u>foolishness</u> of a man twists his way, And his heart frets against the LORD.
- Proverbs 24:7 Wisdom is too lofty for a <u>fool</u>; He does not open his mouth in the gate.
- Proverbs 23:9 Do not speak in the hearing of a fool, For he will despise the wisdom of your words.
- Proverbs 26:12 Do you see a man wise in his own eyes? *There is* more hope for a fool than for him.
- Proverbs 28:26 He who trusts in his own heart is a fool, But whoever walks wisely will be delivered.
- Ecclesiastes 5:1 Walk prudently when you go to the house of God; and draw near to hear rather than to give the sacrifice of <u>fools</u>, for they do not know that they do evil.
- Mark 7:21-22 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:

### Talk

- Proverbs 10:18 Whoever hides hatred has lying lips, And whoever spreads slander is a fool.
- Proverbs 12:23 A prudent man conceals knowledge, But the heart of fools proclaims foolishness.

- Proverbs 13:16 Every prudent *man* acts with knowledge, But a <u>fool</u> lays open *his* folly.
- Proverbs 14:3 In the mouth of a <u>fool</u> is a rod of pride, But the lips of the wise will preserve them.
- Proverbs 15:14 The heart of him who has understanding seeks knowledge, But the mouth of fools feeds on foolishness.
- Proverbs 17:7 Excellent speech is not becoming to a <u>fool</u>, Much less lying lips to a prince.
- Proverbs 17:28 Even a <u>fool</u> is counted wise when he holds his peace; *When* he shuts his lips, *he is considered* perceptive.
- Proverbs 18:2 A <u>fool</u> has no delight in understanding, But in expressing his own heart.
- Proverbs 18:6 A <u>fool</u>'s lips enter into contention, And his mouth calls for blows.
- Proverbs 18:7 A <u>fool</u>'s mouth *is* his destruction, And his lips *are* the snare of his soul.
- Proverbs 19:1 Better *is* the poor who walks in his integrity than *one who is* perverse in his lips, and is a <u>fool</u>.
- Proverbs 20:3 It is honorable for a man to stop striving, Since any <u>fool</u> can start a quarrel.
- Proverbs 26:7 Like the legs of the lame that hang limp *Is* a proverb in the mouth of <u>fools</u>.
- Proverbs 26:9 Like a thorn that goes into the hand of a drunkard Is a proverb in the mouth of fools.
- Proverbs 29:11 A <u>fool</u> vents all his feelings, But a wise *man* holds them back.
- Proverbs 29:20 Do you see a man hasty in his words? *There is* more hope for a <u>fool</u> than for him.
- Ecclesiastes 5:3 For a dream comes through much activity, And a <u>fool</u>'s voice *is known* by *his* many words.
- Ecclesiastes 10:14 A <u>fool</u> also multiplies words. No man knows what is to be; Who can tell him what will be after him?
- Isaiah 32:6 For the foolish person will speak <u>foolishness</u>, And his heart will work iniquity: To practice ungodliness, To utter error against the LORD, To keep the hungry unsatisfied, And he will cause the drink of the thirsty to fail.

#### Actions

- Proverbs 12:16 A <u>fool</u>'s wrath is known at once, But a prudent *man* covers shame.
- Proverbs 14:9 Fools mock at sin, but among the upright there is favor.
- Proverbs 14:16 A wise *man* fears and departs from evil, But a fool rages and is self-confident.
- Proverbs 14:24 The crown of the wise is their riches, *But* the foolishness of fools *is* folly.
- Proverbs 14:33 Wisdom rests in the heart of him who has understanding, But *what is* in the heart of fools is made known.
- Proverbs 15:2 The tongue of the wise uses knowledge rightly, But the mouth of fools pours forth <u>foolishness</u>.
- Proverbs 15:5 A <u>fool</u> despises his father's instruction, But he who receives correction is prudent.
- Proverbs 15:7 The lips of the wise disperse knowledge, But the heart of the <u>fool</u> does not do so.
- Proverbs 17:12 Let a man meet a bear robbed of her cubs, Rather than a <u>fool</u> in his folly.
- Proverbs 24:9 The devising of <u>foolishness</u> is sin, And the scoffer is an abomination to men.
- Proverbs 26:11 As a dog returns to his own vomit, *So* a <u>fool</u> repeats his folly.
- Proverbs 27:3 A stone is heavy and sand is weighty, But a <u>fool</u>'s wrath is heavier than both of them.
- Proverbs 27:22 Though you grind a <u>fool</u> in a mortar with a pestle along with crushed grain, *Yet* his foolishness will not depart from him.
- Ecclesiastes 2:14 The wise man's eyes *are* in his head, But the <u>fool</u> walks in darkness.
- Ecclesiastes 7:5 It is better to hear the rebuke of the wise than for a man to hear the song of <u>fools</u>.
- Ecclesiastes 7:9 Do not hasten in your spirit to be angry, For anger rests in the bosom of <u>fools</u>.
- Ecclesiastes 10:3 Even when a <u>fool</u> walks along the way, He lacks wisdom, And he shows everyone *that* he *is* a <u>fool</u>.
- Ecclesiastes 10:15 The labor of <u>fools</u> wearies them, For they do not even know how to go to the city!

Jeremiah 17:11 *As* a partridge that broods but does not hatch, *So is* he who gets riches, but not by right; It will leave him in the midst of his days, And at his end he will be a <u>fool</u>.

Proverbs 20:1 Wine *is* a mocker, Strong drink *is* a brawler, And whoever is deceived thereby is not wise.

### How to leave the foolish path

### The rod

Proverbs 19:29 Judgments are prepared for scoffers, And beatings for the backs of <u>fools</u>.

Proverbs 26:3 A whip for the horse, A bridle for the donkey, And a rod for the <u>fool</u>'s back.

Proverbs 22:15 <u>Foolishness</u> *is* bound up in the heart of a child; The rod of correction will drive it far from him.

### Seek understanding and wisdom in Christ

Proverbs 8:5 O you simple ones, understand prudence, And you <u>fools</u>, be of an understanding heart.

Proverbs 9:6 Forsake <u>foolishness</u> and live, And go in the way of understanding.

Ephesians 5:15 See then that you walk circumspectly, not as <u>fools</u> but as wise.

### Luxury, riches, and honor to be withheld from a fool

Proverbs 19:10 Luxury is not fitting for a <u>fool</u>, Much less for a servant to rule over princes.

Proverbs 26:1 As snow in summer and rain in harvest, So honor is not fitting for a <u>fool</u>.

Proverbs 26:8 Like one who binds a stone in a sling is he who gives honor to a fool.

### Helping a fool

Proverbs 26:4 Do not answer a <u>fool</u> according to his folly, Lest you also be like him.

Proverbs 26:5 Answer a <u>fool</u> according to his folly, Lest he be wise in his own eyes.
